Academics

- Finish strong academically! You will have to provide your Senior Year transcript to the NCAA/NAIA, and the college you will be attending.
- Complete the FAFSA on October 1st. (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) Determine your families EFC.
- Submit college applications as soon as possible.

Athletics

- Get an updated college prospect evaluation! 1Top Prospect offers college prospect evaluations.
- Attend college showcase/camps at the targeted schools you want to attend.
- Continue posting videos as much as possible on baseball site profiles and social media.
- Signing date - November 9th. (National Letter of Intent) Woohoo! Congratulations!!!
- Be sure to follow any of the NCAA/NAIA's requests and compliant to any of their requests. (They will submit videos for you to watch from time to time. Stay on top of the requests and follow through after you receive their requests.)
- Submit your final transcript with your Senior Year grades to the NCAA/NAIA plus the college you will attending.
