

Sophomore Year Recruiting Checklist

Academics

- Check in with your guidance counselor and figure out which classes you can take this year, making sure you're maintaining your NCAA & NAIA Eligibility. Stay on track with the required core courses, such as a foreign language.
- Post your Freshman year transcript to your baseball profile and social media accounts.

Athletics

- Get an updated college prospect evaluation! 1Top Prospect offers college prospect evaluations.
- Select college showcases / college camps to attend. Make to at least one inexpensive college showcase/camp with the most amount of coaches in attendance. Maximize your exposure.
- Contacting college coaches by sending them letters including videos. (Keep in mind, coaches can only contact/reply to you during certain times of the year depending on the college division.)
- Post videos - as much as possible on your baseball profile and social media accounts.
- Get contact information from your coaches and ask them to be an athletic reference for you.
- Plan a few college visits. When visiting different campuses, you will see what type of environment you like. Most colleges offer online campus tours too.
- Get comfortable speaking with college coaches by practicing with your recruiting coach, travel baseball coach, or family.
