

Junior Year Recruiting Checklist

Academics

- Check in with your guidance counselor. Are you on track to graduate on time with the required number of NCAA & NAIA core courses?
- Post your Sophomore Year transcripts to your baseball profile and your social media accounts.

Athletics

- Register with the NCAA & or the NAIA at the Eligibility Center. (Depending on which is affiliated with the college you are leaning towards attending. If not sure, can register for both the NCAA & NAIA.)
- Get an updated college prospect evaluation! 1Top Prospect offers college prospect evaluations.
- Evaluate your personal recruiting plan. If you need help with your recruiting journey, now is the time to hire a recruiting coach before it's too late. 1Top Prospect can help you find multiple collegiate baseball opportunities with scholarships.
- Decide what schools are on your "Top 10 List" of programs that are actively recruiting you. Make sure you visit those colleges to see if it's a good fit. Be sure to arrange meetings with the coaching staff during your visits.
- Contacting college coaches by sending them letters including videos. (Coaches can email you back starting September 1st.) Send updates to coaches that you have already contacted.
- Post videos as much as possible on baseball site profiles and social media.
- Get comfortable speaking with college coaches by practicing.
